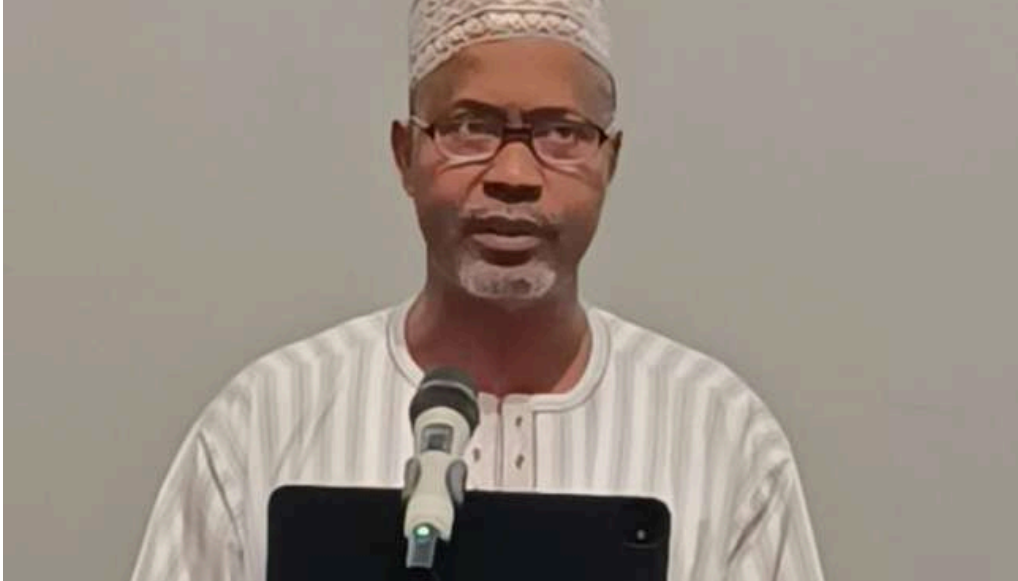


## University of West England Hosts CASET Launch

## We Will Increase Funding For Universities – Tinubu

President Bola Ahmed Tinubu has promised to increase funding for federal universities to meet global standards. Speaking at the 35th convocation of the Adeyemi Federal University of Education, Ondo (AFUED) in Ondo State, Tinubu acknowledged the challenges facing the nation’s universities, including inadequate funding, infrastructure decay, and insecurity. Tinubu, who was represented by the Vice-Chancellor of Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife, Osun,

Prof. Adebayo Bamire, assured Nigerians that his administration is taking steps to address these issues and has factored universities into its plans for more funding. Tinubu also highlighted the perennial challenges faced by tertiary institutions, including paucity of funds, infrastructural decadence, and shortage of manpower. He, however, assured that his administration is committed to addressing these challenges

decisively. “This administration is not oblivious of the predicaments in the universities. The paucity of funds to enhance administrative matters is a general and perennial challenge for most tertiary institutions. “Other challenges like infrastructural decadence, shortage of manpower and growing insecurity of cult fraternities, among others, are on the campuses.

“We are taking commensurate steps to address these challenges decisively,” he said.

He emphasised the importance of education in shaping the future of the country and encouraged students to take advantage of the opportunities available to them.

Also speaking, the Acting Vice-Chancellor of the institution, Prof. Samuel Akintunde, revealed that 12,556 students were being conferred with first degrees, while 6,269 were receiving the Nigerian

Certificate in Education (NCE).

He disclosed that 51 students had First Class, 3,090 had Second Class

Upper, 6,805 got Second Class Lower, 2,087 got Third Class, and 154 got Pass.

While commending the roles played by notable individuals, including the First Lady, Sen. Oluremi Tinubu, and Prof. Toyin Falola, Akintunde noted that the institution is yet to receive a take-off grant since its upgrade and urged the government to provide support.

“It is essential to build two or three faculties and remodel the existing structures to occupy other faculties. Also, the laboratories and resource centres are yet to be upgraded,” he said.

The convocation ceremony also saw the conferment of honorary doctorate degrees on notable individuals, including the First Lady, Sen. Oluremi Tinubu, and Prof. Toyin Falola. The ceremony was attended by prominent dignitaries, and it marked a significant milestone in the university’s history.

## FG Proposes Establishment of Exams Malpractice Tribunal

The Federal Government has proposed the establishment of National Examination

Malpractice Court/Tribunal for prompt prosecution of examination malpractices to serve as deterrent to others in the country.

Minister of Education, Dr. Olatunji Alausa affirmed this recommendation of the 17-man committee headed by Professor Is-haq Oloyede, Registrar of the Joint Administrations and Matriculation Board (JAMB) as chairman, on Improvement of the Quality of Examination in Nigeria.

The Committee which the Minister

inaugurated in January this year, submitted its interim report to him on Friday after about five months

of extensive work, coming up with far-reaching recommendations aimed at improving the quality of

examination and curbing examination malpractices in Nigeria.

Professor Oloyede in one of the recommendations, asked the Federal Ministry of Education to interface with the National Assembly to enact an Act to establish a National Examination Malpractice Court/Tribunal for prompt prosecution of examination malpractices to serve as deterrent to others.

In his response, the Honorable Minister of Education assured the committee members that all the 12-point recommendations would be implemented, saying government would deploy all its machineries to fight the menace of examination malpractice in Nigeria.

He said: “Let me assure all the committee members that you have done so much work here and all the recommendations you have given us as a government, we will implement every single one of them because you put a lot of your passion, emotion, weight, effort into this.

“All the 12 recommendations that you reeled out, everyone will agree with me today that none of those recommendations, will be impossible to implement. They are all practicable things. The one that we will implement now, we will do that right away and once we leave here myself and the permanent Secretary have work to do.”

Some of the recommendations of the Oloyede committee included: “All documents, including certificates, registration and result slips, etc., should contain National

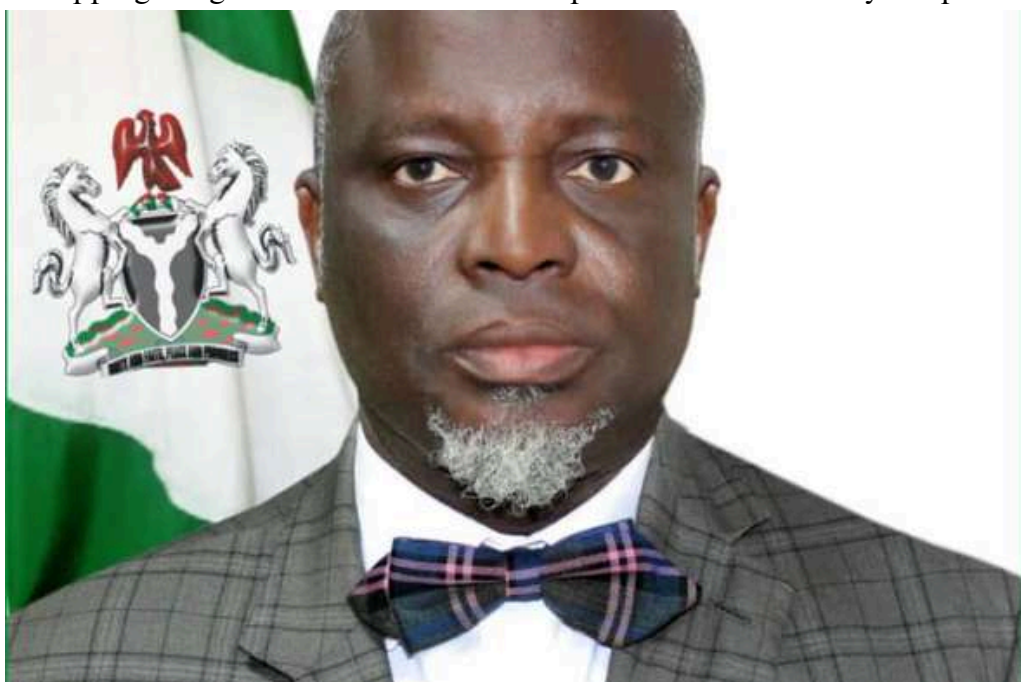
Identification Number (NIN), photograph and date of birth to guard against identity theft and impersonation.

“All invigilators and supervisors must register through NIN and subscribe to the Examination body’s Short Code, using the same pattern of 55019/66019 of JAMB in order so track and have full information about the examination officials, including examiners, supervisors and invigilators.

“Swapping invigilators and

Supervisors, not candidates, should commence with effect from the 2025 private SSCE due to the strong views against student swapping expressed by the four concerned examination bodies (WAEC, NECO, NABTEB and NBAIS) pertaining to security, logistics and the fact that centre details are traditionally printed on candidates certificates.

“Except where absolutely impossible, Invigilators and Supervisors should always be public

officials/teachers on pensionable appointments.

“The standard requirements of examination halls/centres should not be waived for any school, while the recommended seating arrangement should be 1.5m by 1.2m. or 1.8 sqm per candidate.

“All examination halls and centres should be equipped with stationary CCTV cameras for surveillance and monitoring purposes. In addition every examination centre shall have a mini control room where the CCTV camera is monitored for urgent and immediate alert.

“All the four concerned examination bodies shall jointly own central control facilities for their use during their examinations to save cost; and body camcorders should be deployed to examination halls and centres for effective monitoring.

### CALL FOR NOMINATION/APPLICATION FOR YEAR 2025

The Governing Board of the Nigerian National Merit Award is currently soliciting nominations or applications for the award of the Nigerian National Order of Merit (NNOM) for 2025. The deadline for nomination is **31<sup>st</sup> March, 2025**. Nominations are valid only for the year of nomination. However, candidates who have been previously nominated should state clearly additional work(s) done since they were last nominated or the new grounds for re-consideration of their nomination.

#### ABOUT NNMA

NNMA is a value driven agency of the Federal Republic of Nigeria. It was established by Act 53 of 1979 as amended by Act 96 of 1992 (CAP 122 LFN, 2004). The Mission statement for NNMA reads: "Committed to stimulating and rewarding, academic and professional excellence for national development of Nigeria".

#### THE NNOM AWARD

- i. The Nigerian National Order of Merit (NNOM) is an "Order of Dignity" and distinct from the National Honours. It was instituted to accord proper and due recognition for outstanding intellectual and academic attainments and contributions to the general development of Nigeria. The President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria is required by law (NNMA Act Section 8) to confer the NNOM Award annually, on the recipient(s), on the first Thursday in the month of December. The objective of the Award is to stimulate and reward excellence in Science, Engineering/Technology, Medicine, Humanities, Arts & Culture and other fields of human endeavor.
- ii. **A recipient of NNOM Award is entitled to:**
  - a. use the designation Nigeria National Order of Merit (NNOM) after his/her name;
  - b. receive a Cash Prize, a Certificate and a Medal;
  - c. such other privileges as are enjoyed by recipients of high levels of national awards and honours.

## ELIGIBILITY

- i. The Award is open to all citizens of Nigeria at home and abroad.
- ii Any Nigerian citizen of outstanding merit can be nominated by one or more Nigerian citizens. Any person may by himself/herself, where not sponsored by another person, apply to the Board for this purpose. Where two or more Nigerians are collaborating on any deserving undertaking, they can be similarly nominated for a joint Award.

## NOMINATION/APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- i. Nominations shall be made strictly on the prescribed Nomination/Application Form, and in the format therein. Sponsors should provide brief information on themselves. The Nomination/Application Form may either be collected at the NNMA secretariat or downloaded from the NNMA website, [www.nnma.gov.ng](http://www.nnma.gov.ng). The form as advertised is also valid.
- ii. Only one nomination/application may be submitted on the prescribed application form.
- iii. In private consultation with the nominee, the nomination/application form shall be accompanied by:
  - a. The *curriculum vitae* of each candidate.
  - b. A statement, preferably by the candidate, of between 250 – 500 words, specifying/defining and clearly illustrating in concrete terms, NOT generalities, what the candidate considers his/her unique and meritorious contribution to knowledge in his/her field of endeavor/specialization to merit consideration for the NNOM award.
  - c. A list of not more than ten publications cited in the candidate's curriculum vitae which in the nominee's consideration, buttresses his/her claim to uniqueness and merit. Copies of the ten publications must be submitted with the application.
  - d. 3 portrait photographs of the candidate.
- iv. All nominations and supporting documents, including copies of the ten publications submitted to buttress the nominee's claim to uniqueness and merit, must reach the Secretary of the Nigerian National Merit Award on or before the stipulated deadline. Any nomination or application including the specified requirements arriving later than the deadline will not be considered.
- v. All supporting documents, including the nomination form should be sent in three (3) copies.
- vi. Candidates with incomplete documents shall not be considered.
- vii. Neither the Governing Board nor any of its Specialized Committees of Assessors shall entertain or enter into any correspondence with candidates or their sponsors regarding the processing of, or decision on any Nomination.
- viii. The Nomination/Application Form and supporting documents shall be addressed, sealed and delivered on or before 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2025 to:

**SELECTION/CONSIDERATION**

- (i) Selection will be made from the wide range of contemporary works which are innovative, creative, essentially Nigerian in content and of national and international distinction; such works should emphasize the uniqueness of the achievements to humanity generally and Nigerian society in particular.
- (ii) The achievements may constitute a specific break-through in any field or may be of a cumulative nature; and
- (iii) The Award emphasizes distinct merit and upright morality, as this is the highest Merit Award in the Country.
- (iv) Nominators must not make public the names of nominees.
- (v) **Kindly note that any candidate that is found to lobby for the award shall be disqualified.**
- (vi) In order to preserve and enhance the credibility of the Award, the submissions of the prospective recipients are usually subjected to rigorous assessment by experts, known as Specialized Committee of Assessors in the following four core areas:-
  - Science
  - Medicine
  - Engineering/Technology
  - Humanities, Arts and Culture and other fields of human endeavour.
- (vii) When and where necessary, External Assessors are usually engaged from the national or international academic community.

**ANNOUNCEMENT/INVESTITURE**

- (i) Successful candidates will be notified about the outcomes of the process between October and November 2025 to be followed by an official public announcement latest two weeks from the date of Investiture.
- (ii) The Investiture of NNOM Awardee (s) is personally conducted by the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
- (iii) The Investiture holds back-to-back with the Annual Forum of Laureates of the Nigerian National Order of Merit.

## PRESS RELEASE

### MORATORIUM ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES IN NIGERIA

The National Universities Commission is a parastatal under the Federal Ministry of Education charged with the orderly development of University Education in Nigeria. By virtue of the provisions of the Education (National Minimum Standards and Establishment of Institutions) Act, CAP E3, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004, the Commission is empowered to provide guidelines for the establishment of private universities in Nigeria.

In exercise of its mandates, the Commission has since 1999 recommended and the Federal Government has approved the establishment of 149 private universities in Nigeria to date.

The Commission, in its efforts at repositioning Private Universities in Nigeria to better meet the needs of the citizenry and for better co-ordination of the development of the Private University Education sub-sector of the Nigerian University System (NUS), has identified the need to review the guidelines for the establishment of private universities. This is to ensure that newly established private universities are positioned to meet the challenges of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

Pursuant to the above and in line with the **directive** of the Honourable Minister of Education, the National Universities Commission hereby informs Promoters of proposed Private Universities in particular and the general public as follows:


1. The Commission hereby suspends further processing of:
  - a. All inactive applications including those of private open universities (i.e. those that have not made progress on their applications or made submissions to the Commission for upwards of two years), and
  - b. Applications at the stage of submission of Letters of Intent only;
2. The Fee for purchase of Application Forms for the Establishment of a Private University is hereby reviewed from One Million (₦1,000,000.00) Naira to (Five Million (₦5,000,000.00) Naira;

3. The Processing Fee for Application for the Establishment of a Private University is hereby reviewed from Five Million (₦5,000,000.00) Naira to Twenty-Five Million (₦25,000,000.00) Naira;
4. The NUC will convey the reviewed Processing Fee of Twenty-Five Million (₦25,000,000.00) Naira to applicants that have purchased Application Forms only. They are also expected to effect payments within a period of thirty (30) **working days** or risk forfeiture of their pending applications;
5. The Commission hereby imposes a ***Moratorium for a period of one year with effect from Monday, 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2025*** on:
  - a. Inactive applications for the establishment of new private universities to enable the Commission to conduct a comprehensive review of such pending applications with a view to determining their viability;
  - b. Applications on Step 1 of the 14-Step Procedure (i.e. those that have submitted Letters of Intent only), and
  - c. Acceptance of fresh applications for the establishment of private universities, including private open universities;
6. The Commission is in the process of reviewing other aspects of the Guidelines for the Establishment of Private Universities in Nigeria to ensure that the proposed Universities, when licensed, are positioned to meet the challenges of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. Details of the review would be communicated to Stakeholders in due course.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Commission will continue to process pending active applications and make appropriate recommendations to the Federal Executive Council for approval.

## 1. OBJECTIVE

The objective of the program is to contribute to the development of human capital in other countries and to support the education of foreign nationals in higher education institutions of Azerbaijan by granting scholarships on full-time basis at the Bachelor's (including general medicine education), Master's (including medical residency), Doctoral levels, as well as the preparatory courses.

## 2. EDUCATIONAL LEVELS

### 3. SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS

The applicants approved for the Scholarship will be provided with the following:

#### 5. APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. Citizens of the Republic of Azerbaijan or individuals whose citizenship in the Republic of Azerbaijan have been terminated will not be considered for a Scholarship;
2. Age requirements for applicants shall be as follows:
  - Undergraduate and general medicine programs – foreign nationals below 35 years as of 15.09.2025;
  - Graduate and medical residency programs – foreign nationals below 40 years as of 15.09.2025;
  - Doctoral programs – foreign nationals below 45 years as of 15.09.2025.

**Selection Committee at any time may verify the authenticity of the information provided by the applicant and proceed according to current regulations.**

#### 6. APPLICATION PROCESS

For official nomination by the respective state entities/government authorities (Ministries, Embassies, etc.) the applicants must submit the required documents to the relevant authorities for the first stage of the application process. The last date of the submission is May 15, 2025 at 6 PM Baku time.

If the candidates are officially nominated by the respective government authorities they will proceed to the second stage of the application process and apply through Study in Azerbaijan Centralized Admission Service (SIACAS) website (portal.edu.az) from June 1 to June 15, 2025. After logging in SIACAS website applicants must choose the relevant Admission channel (“Heydar Aliyev - International Education Grant” program) to apply.

Candidates can choose 3 (three) specialties at different higher educational institutions of the Republic of Azerbaijan in the appropriate channel.



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Applicants may track status of their applications and get notifications for the next stages from the SIACAS. At the same time, notifications will appear in applicant's personal account.

SIACAS website will remain accessible to registration of applications from June 1, 2025, starting at 12 AM, to June 15 at 6 PM Baku time.

A candidate with multiple nationalities may submit only one application, and it must be for one of the eligible nations (Annex 2) listed in this Call for Applications (it must be submitted in accordance with the applicant's nationality as nominated by the relevant state bodies).

Only the applications that were nominated by their respective countries in the first stage will go through the evaluation process for the Scholarship program.

## 7. REQUIREMENTS

1. Completed [nomination form](#) (for the first stage of application process);
2. Copy of Diplomas and Transcripts from prior High School or Higher Education Institution; The applicant's academic marks (GPA) of the previous degree(s) of study (general secondary education, bachelor's degree, general medicine education, master's degree, medical residency) must not be less than 70 (on a scale of 0 to 100 or 7 on a scale of 10 or equivalent) of the relevant marking system;
3. Copy of the medical certificate (including HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis B/C tests);
4. Copy of a valid passport that confirms the applicant's identification information;
5. CV or Resume;
6. Proficiency in the language of study:
  - Applicants willing to study in English are required to have following scores:
  - for undergraduate programs minimum IELTS 5 (TOEFL 40);
  - for postgraduate programs minimum IELTS 5.5 (TOEFL 50);
  - the language of study of the previous education must be English.



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- Applicants willing to study in Russian - proof of language proficiency or the language of study of the previous education must be Russian;
- Applicants willing to study in Turkish - proof of language proficiency or the language of study of the previous education must be in Turkish;
- Applicants willing to study in Azerbaijani – proof of the English, Russian or Turkish language or the language of study of the previous education must be English, Russian or Turkish.

The higher education institution may examine the candidate's proficiency for the applied level of education and proficiency in the language of study.

7. Motivation letter;

8. Local and international awards (if available).

### 7.1 PREREQUISITE FOR THE DOCUMENTS

1. Documents must be legible/readable and clear;
2. Documents must be in one of the following languages: Azerbaijani, Turkish, English and Russian languages and have to be notarized;
3. Documents in a language other than those indicated above must be accompanied by a notarized translation into English;
4. The applicant must submit the documentation in PDF format;
5. Candidates must submit a medical certificate (including HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis B and C tests) from the relevant clinics in the country of residence. The medical certificate has to be dated no more than 3 (three) months before the submission of application and must verify that the applicant is in good health for travel and study (if the certificate is in a language other than Azerbaijani, Turkish, English and Russian, it should have a certified translation);
6. All requested documents must be uploaded along with the application in the SIACAS website before the deadline (June 15 at 6 PM GMT Baku time).



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### 8. RESULTS

1. In accordance with the schedule mentioned in Part 4 (*Timeline of the Call*) of this call, the decision on the acceptance to the scholarship program will be sent by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and through SIACAS website;
2. If the selected applicant does not confirm the participation at the Scholarship program through SIACAS website within the established deadline, the Application Committee may grant the scholarship to another applicant who meets the abovementioned requirements;
3. Official nomination of the candidates by the respective government authorities (Ministries, Embassies, etc.) of their country does not guarantee the grant of the scholarship by the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan;
4. The final decision on the grant of the scholarships is solely up to the Selection Committee;
5. All decisions made during the selection process are final and not subject to appeal.

### 9. CONSIDERATIONS

1. Any expense that is not specified in this Call for Applications will not be covered or reimbursed by the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan;
2. The selected applicant will receive instructions to initiate the process of formalizing the scholarship grant. If Application Committee does not receive a response to its communications within the established timeframe, it may result in the cancellation of the scholarship grant and the selection of another applicant;
3. The selected applicants will receive guideline about their stay in the Republic of Azerbaijan. They may get the information about scholarship holder's rights and obligations, visa, migration rules, as well as other useful materials;
4. The selected applicant will be considered as a scholarship recipient only after delivering the required documentation to the offices of the higher education institution in the Republic of Azerbaijan, and will be subject to the commitments of Agreement of this Scholarship Program;
5. The selected applicant, upon accepting the scholarship, commits to complying with the Agreement signed by grant holder and the higher educational institution, as well as keeping up-to-date with the respective departments assigned to the candidates by higher education institutions during scholarship period.
